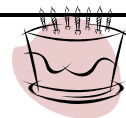

Patient Care Representative Davonna Saier recently shared this letter with us from a family of a CBH patient:

My brother Gary D. Howard was a patient there in April of this year. He was admitted with a heart attack, ended up having surgery, died in recovery, was revived, and died a week later. His surgeon, Dr. Imam, showed compassion and determination. Everyone there was kind, professional, caring, and went the second mile and beyond for my brother and for our family! We camped out there at the hospital for two weeks and were treated like royal guests. Though we never stopped praying for Gary to live, the fact that he was revived and we had him for another week was priceless. He had time to say goodbye and some very important conversations took place. I want the staff to know, though we were heartbroken when he died, we all knew we had already had a miracle. We were able to be with him for the week before Easter and were able to spend Easter Sunday with him. The significance was not lost on us. We will see our brother again. Your staff; medical, chaplains, **volunteers**, cafeteria, everyone there made the transition easier, and we thank you.
