This is an extremely intensive program for which our teen volunteers have to apply separately after they have already begun volunteering. The young people, typically rising high school seniors and those who have just graduated, must demonstrate maturity and a commitment to the healthcare profession.

The VolunTeen Fellowship is a two-week, 40-hours/week, program comprised of four primary components: a service project, rotations through different areas of the hospital, leadership training and journaling/debriefing.

This year, we were fortunate to have former Governor Martha Layne Collins as one of the leadership speakers.

We were also fortunate that this year, a member of our 2009 VolunTeen Fellowship, Asri Mumpuni, returned to assist and encourage the VolunTeen Fellows. We're excited about the possibilities for 2012!
